Dear Seniors, Parents and Guardians,

Governor Wolf extended the period of time for the Pennsylvania school closure indefinitely, and this letter will provide you with up-to-date information related to our seniors and upcoming scheduled events.

Senior graduation is scheduled for Thursday, June 11th. Due to the indefinite closure of schools, if we are unable to hold graduation as planned, we will reschedule. We will keep you posted on the new date, if necessary.

The Senior Prom, scheduled for Friday, May 29th has been postponed. The administration is determined to give our seniors the celebration of the prom, as deserved.
