How do I get my cap and gown? What does it cost?

Get ready to shine! The administration will be in touch soon with your appointment on either <u>June 9</u> <u>or June 10 from 10-2 pm</u> for coming to the school to put on your cap and gown for a video that will be used in the virtual ceremony. You will want to look your best for your appointment. You will also receive your yard sign, any senior awards that you have earned, and a senior shirt. *Please wear a mask when entering the building*.

There will be no charge for the Class of 2020 for caps and gowns, and you will be able to take them home after your appointment.

Do I have to turn in my computer?

Yes - bring your computer when you come to the school on June 9 or June 10. You will be able to pick it back up during the summer. Do not turn in your charger.

Prom?

Unfortunately, it has become clear that it will be impossible for there to be a prom this summer. Every Class of 2020 Senior will receive a free yearbook for your prom fundraising efforts.
